Dispose of at one of the ECUA's Household Hazardous Waste Collection Days.

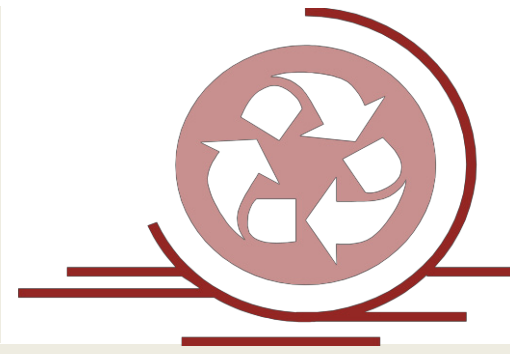
Used Clothing

There will be NO regular collection of Garbage on the following dates. Regular collection will take place on the next collection date as indicated:

Christmas Tree Collection

Christmas trees placed at the curb by residents will be picked up on:
January 4, 11, 18, 25, 2017

Trees placed in plastic bags will not be collected.

Garbage/Refuse Collection Information

Verona provides twice per week collection of garbage/refuse and disposes of approximately 5,000 tons of material annually at the Essex County Incinerator through its collection contractor. The residents are requested to place their normal household garbage/refuse for collection curbside not earlier than 7pm on the night before the scheduled collection day, nor later than 6 am on the day of collection in accordance with the schedule. In addition, residents are also asked to place their items for collection in refuse containers or sealed rodent resistant disposable bags weighing less than 50 lbs. Please save and refer to the Collection Schedule insert for your collection dates.

Normal household waste includes garbage and/or refuse of any kind incidental to the normal operation of the household and/or business, but does not include the following items:

Recyclables, Newspaper, Junk Mail and Magazines, Commingled Materials, Electronic Waste, Grass, Leaves/Yard Waste, Tires, Motor Oil, Mixed Paper, Paint Cans or Other Hazardous Household Waste, Corrugated Cardboard, Chipboard, Bulky Waste, White Goods, Construction/Remodeling Materials, NiCd Rechargeable Batteries.

All of these materials should not be included in your garbage for disposal, but separated and handled in accordance with this brochure's guidance.

Residents are encouraged to separate these materials from the household as means for reducing the township's disposal costs and to help improve our environment.

Recycling of Special Materials

Special materials such as Tires, NiCad Batteries & Motor Oil should be collected and then brought to the Public Works Yard for Recycling. The Recycling Center located at Commerce Court is open on Saturday from 8:30am - 3:30pm, and Wednesday from 8:30am - 3:30pm, throughout the year for the acceptance of these materials.

Corrugated Cardboard - Residents are encouraged to recycle cardboard. Cardboard will now be collected curbside along with all paper products on the designated days. The two primary types of cardboard are corrugated cardboard, used primarily for shipping items and chipboard which is usually cereal, gift, cracker and cake mix boxes, etc. Clean corrugated cardboard should be flattened and placed at the curb for collection. Clean chipboard should be placed at the curb for collection on your designated collection day for All Paper & Cardboard. Juice boxes, milk containers, dirty pizza boxes, plastic wrapping and styrofoam should be placed in your garbage for collection.

All Paper Products - All paper products including chipboard will be collected curbside along with cardboard on the designated days.

Residents are directed to place recyclables in designated areas

Tires - Tires are disposed at the Public Works Yard on Ozone Avenue after first securing a Disposal Permit from the Public Works Administration Office on Commerce Court. Permits may be secured Monday-Friday (8:30am - 3:30pm)

- Passenger Tire Permit - \$5.00/tire
- Truck Tire Permit - \$10.00/tire
- Remove Tire from Rim before disposal and Place Metal Rim in Metal Container
- Dispose Tire in the designated area of the Public Works Yard.

Batteries & Motor Oil - NiCad batteries should be collected and brought to the Public Works Garage and placed in the designated container for Recycling. Used Motor Oil can be recycled by emptying the oil in the Used Oil Container located in the Public Works Garage, Monday-Friday, 8:00AM to 4:00 PM.

***Electronic Equipment** - Electronic Equipment is no longer accepted at the Recycling Depot. See below for drop-off details

Collection>>> Grass, Leaves/Yard Waste

• Vegetative Waste such as Grass, Leaves and other Yard Waste materials may no longer be placed with other Solid Waste for disposal, but is now required to be Recycled as required by NJDEP.

• Grass, Leaves, Yard Waste consisting of hedge and bush clippings, weeds and other vegetative materials when packed in biodegradable bags or tied in bundles weighing less than fifty (50) pounds is now picked-up curbside on Wednesdays from March 1 - December 27 by the Garbage Collection Contractor.

• Public Works Department Crews will also be picking-up vegetative waste material collected in biodegradable paper bags and placed at the curb by residents during the peak spring and fall collection seasons.

• Only Vegetative Waste placed in biodegradable bags will be picked-up on designated collection days. Material placed in plastic bags will NOT be picked-up.

• Residents are limited to four (4) bags or bundles per pick-up which must be placed at the curb no later than 6:30 am on the day of collection or no earlier than 7:00pm on the day before collection.

• In addition to the weekly collection, residents may bring their Vegetative Waste for composting to the terminus of Commerce Court on the dates below in accordance with the following hours of operation: Sundays, Wednesdays & Saturdays: 8:30am - 3:30pm; Sundays: 12:00noon - 3:00pm.

• Biodegradable Kraft paper bags are available for sale from the Public Works Administration Office on Commerce Court at a cost of \$ 0.35 per bag.

• Brush, tree limbs, tree trunks, bushes, shrubs and tree roots greater the 2" in diameter or not capable of being tied in bundles or placed in biodegradable bags are the responsibility of the owner/tenant to properly dispose of.

• Gardeners servicing Verona residents are required to secure a permit from Public Works before being allowed to dump yard waste at the Commerce Court site.

• Residents are reminded that raking or blowing of leaves or other vegetative waste into the street is unsafe and prohibited by Township Ordinance.

Construction & Remodeling Materials

Construction /Remodeling Materials, such as concrete, concrete or cement cinder blocks, bricks, asphalt, slate, railroad ties, plywood, metal or wooden fencing, doors, roofing materials, plaster, sheetrock, lumber, paint, earth, sheds, stones, rocks, windows, sinks, tubs, cabinets, ceramic tile, insulation materials, pane glass, leaders and gutters, remodeling materials, siding materials, and other construction material are the responsibility of the owner, tenant, or occupant to dispose of properly and will NOT be picked-up by the township. Residents requiring disposal of these materials must contact a private disposal company for pick-up and not place these items at the curb.

Propane Tanks

Empty propane tanks can be deposited at the recycle center only after receiving a permit from Public Works for \$5.00 per tank. Public Works Office at 10 Commerce Court is open Monday through Friday from 8:30 am to 4:30 pm.

Rechargeable Batteries

NiCad/Rechargeable batteries ranging from the small 1.5V AAA batteries, to cell phone, laptop and power tool batteries can be disposed of at one of the ECUA's Household Hazardous Waste Collection Days or at the Public Works Garage.
